


## **CHEERS WITH A CAUSE**

### **MD ANDERSON LUNCHEON**

Last month, **Heather Whitfield, Marcy Cann,** and **Jenee Bobbora** attended a celebration at MD Anderson in honor of reaching 1,000 patients on the registry for the Morgan Welch IBC Clinic. It was an impactful event, highlighting all

of the successes of the clinic as a result of the work and philanthropic efforts of a few key organizations, including the HAA chapter of ZTA. Since 2005, the HAA Chapter of ZTA has donated \$334,426.91 to MD Anderson. This also includes over \$189,000 directly to the Morgan Welch Inflammatory Breast Cancer Program and \$55,000 for the ZTA HAA Fellowship. Our donation for this fellowship funded the travel of Drs. Villodre, Hu, and Debeb to present their research at the San Antion Breast Cancer Symposium and AACR. It was a wonderful reminder of why we put in so much effort for our Think Pink Luncheon. Everyone was so grateful for our funding and all the work that our sisters have done. Thank you all.
